



## VM2022 Bulletin 4 - Shipping to Lahaina

Several 2022 Vic-Maui skippers have been inquiring about shared shipping of return-delivery items to Lahaina.

Relatively light items such as sails may qualify to be shipped via air freight from YVR to OGG (Maui).

Heavy items such as anchors or chain rode most likely do not.

A dedicated container on a round trip basis doesn't make economic sense in this situation. However, it may make sense for individual boats to send individual shipments on an LCL (less than container load) basis.

Heavy items can be shipped from Seattle using Seattle based shippers. Shipping from Vancouver to Maui via Seattle increases the cost significantly due to brokerage fees and transportation costs. Each skipper is responsible for their own cross border handling and delivery to the shipper in Seattle.
